- Shanghai literally means "Above/Upon the Sea," which alludes to the city's location along the Yangtze River Delta near the South China Sea. As an excellent sea and river port, it boasts easy access to the vast hinterland of China;
- Shanghai aims to become an international center for economics, finance, trade, shipping, technology and innovation by the year of 2035;
- The city is divided into two parts by the Huangpu River: Puxi is the older part of the city and hosts the majority of shops and museums; Pudong is the modern part, and is recognized for its extremely impressive high-rises;
- Shanghai has become a gastronomic center of all the major cuisine of China. The downtown area also has a plethora of glitzy foreign restaurants to suit the palate of international tourists.

REQUIREMENTS FOR ENGLISH-TAUGHT PROGRAMS

- 1) Applicant must currently be enrolled as a post-graduate student or third/fourth-year undergraduate student:
- 2) Non-native English speakers must have one of the following:
- > TOEFL score of 92iBT
- > IELTS score 6.5
- > Certificates that prove student who has studied for at least two years at, or received a degree from an English speaking high school, college, or university

APPLICATION DOCUMENTS

- 1) SISU Application Form for Exchange Students
- 2) Certification of study at home university
- 3) Motivation letter/ Study plan
- 4) Letter of nomination by the international office of home university
- 5) Photocopy of passport
- 6) Two passport photos (size: 5cm*4cm)
- 7) Photocopy of English proficiency certificate (for English-taught programs)







DURATION AND APPLICATION DEADLINE

The program lasts one or two semesters. The Fall semester starts in early September, while the Spring semester starts in late February.

ADMISSION

Once accepted, applicants will receive an admission package including an acceptance letter, visa application form (JW202 form) and registration information.

Applicants who wish to study for more than one semester are required to do a physical examination in advance. It should be done in a national or public hospital in their home country within 4 months prior to the registration date at SISU. If the applicant is in China, he/she should do it at the local Entry-Exit Inspection and Quarantine Bureau.
